	Activity	Level of Government	Explanation
1	Eating food	Federal	The federal government provides food
2	Going to a park	Federal	The federal government regulates public parks
3	Going to school	State	The state government regulates public education
4	Going to the store	Federal	The federal government regulates what can, can't, and should be sold at grocery stores
5	Simply being at home	Federal	The federal government regulates housing
7	Seeing advertisements online	Federal	The federal government regulates online marketing and advertising
6	Where I live	Local	Local governments regulate where residential, commercial, and industrial buildings are located
8	Public safety	Local	Local governments are in control of the location and regulation of fire departments, police stations, and medical emergency services
9	Public safety (extended)	State	The state government regulates rules behind human testing
10	Transportation	Local	Public transportation and other transportation services are regulated by the local government



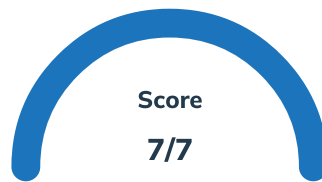
